The Dyslexia Association of Singapore (DAS) provides a continuum of services for children with dyslexia, their parents, mainstream teachers and other professionals in the field of dyslexia in Singapore.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Position	Educational Therapist (Preschool) - Sessional
Division/Branch	Preschool Programme, SES Division

We are looking for individuals with a passion in teaching Preschool but are not able to commit to a full time job. Candidates must be able to commit to a minimum of 6 teaching hours per week, and respond at short notice to cover classes at the different DAS learning centres. They must be able to commit to this arrangement for a minimum of two years.

About our Preschool Programme

The aim of the Preschool Programme is to help Preschoolers who are potentially at risk of having dyslexia or developmental delay in early literacy, develop skills and strategies to become confident achievers when they enter primary school.

The programme helps Preschoolers acquire a good foundation in alphabet knowledge and phonograms, leading up to learning sight words essential for reading. These abilities gear them towards reading and spelling readiness. They will also be taught strategies to cope with letter reversals. The programme follows a prescribed scope and sequence for systematic, sequential and cumulative teaching.

The duties of DAS Sessional Educational Therapist (Preschool) include

- Lesson planning - Develop teaching methods and instructional materials that meet young students' varying needs while ensuring that students are well engaged and having fun during lessons.
- Teaching - Deliver the Preschool curriculum/ lesson plans to meet the students' needs and abilities.
- Marking students' work
- Filing and maintaining student records as appropriate
- Conducting pre- and post- tests if necessary
- Carrying out parent communication - Sharing information and discussing issues relating to students' learning progress with parents during the school terms.
- Monitoring the progress of the students and writing progress reports every term.
- Teaching at external venues (e.g PCF centres) apart from teaching in DAS learning centres
- Participating in DAS Preschool research efforts when required.

TRAINING PROVIDED

The DAS places great emphasis on providing a professional service. To help Sessional Educational Therapists (Preschool) develop as a teacher, they will attend the following courses

- Certificate in Dyslexia Studies
- Preschool Professional Certificate Course (PCC) in Early Literacy Intervention (Teaching)
- Certificate in Dyslexia and Literacy Teaching (CiDLT)

The DAS will subsidise 50% of the cost of the training, and the Sessional Educational Therapist (Preschool) is required to pay the remaining amount. The course fees borne by the Sessional Educational Therapist (Preschool) will be reimbursed upon achieving 480 hours of satisfactory teaching with the DAS.

While the DAS is invested in providing training and support, Sessional Educational Therapists (Preschool) are expected to invest their personal time for the training and other matters such as attending lectures, completing the necessary course work and preparing lesson plans for the classes they are teaching.

COMMITMENT PERIOD

In view of the investment in our Sessional Educational Therapists (Preschool), they are required to commit to this sessional work arrangement for a minimum of two years (equivalent to teaching 480 hours at a minimum of 6 hours per week). If the Sessional Educational Therapist (Preschool) is unable to fulfil this commitment period, they will not receive any reimbursement for the course fees borne by them.

COMPETENCIES

Personal Competencies (Core) :

REQUIREMENTS

Education:

- Degree from a recognised university (disciplines in Early Childhood Education preferred)
- Teaching Certificate or Diploma in Preschool Education

Experience:

- Relevant background and experience in teaching Preschoolers will be an asset.

Other Skills & Knowledge:

- Strong interpersonal skills

WORKING HOURS

Sessional Educational Therapists (Preschool) are expected to work flexible hours

- a) during weekends at DAS learning centres; and
- b) on weekdays at external venues if required

They are expected to teach a minimum of six (6) hours a week during MOE school terms.

They may also be called upon to respond at short notice to cover classes at the different DAS learning centres.

WORK VENUE

Sessional Educational Therapist (Preschool) must be willing to travel to different DAS learning centres throughout Singapore. They must expect to work from any of our 14 learning centres in Ang Mo Kio, Bedok, Bishan, Chinatown, Chua Chu Kang, Jurong Point, Parkway Parade, Queenstown, Rex, Sengkang, Serangoon, Tampines, Woodlands and Yishun, as well as satellite centres currently located within PCF Sparkletots at Ghim Moh Link, Fengshan, Admiralty and Woodlands.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

Successful candidates will be paid between S\$45 to S\$55 per hour depending on relevant qualifications and teaching experience. These rates are for teaching hours only, and hours for lesson preparation and training will not be paid.

Sessional Educational Therapists (Preschool) will enjoy a 50% discount to attend fee-charging DAS activities including DAS Academy workshops and courses, DAS conferences etc, where deemed relevant by the organisation.

OPPORTUNITY TO JOIN THE REGISTER OF EDUCATIONAL THERAPIST (ASIA) [RETA]

The DAS has initiated the setting up of a Register of trained and experienced professional tutors and therapists who specialise in supporting individuals with dyslexia and/or related specific learning difficulties. The Register is guided by a steering committee which comprises senior DAS staff and individuals working in the private practice and other educational bodies. The Register will provide public recognition of professional training and competence for members. DAS Educational Therapists will have the opportunity to sign up with RETA (<http://www.reta.sg/>) once they have attained the necessary training and experience.
