Screening and assessment services for tertiary learners are available at DAS. Screening might help to determine learners are at-risk whereas assessment services can ascertain a diagnosis and identify areas of strength and ways to help them learn more effectively.

DAS is dedicated to providing tailored interventions that empower these learners with the tools and strategies needed to achieve their true potential.




### **DAS Bursaries**
